## **WINTER STORAGE RESERVATION FORM – Main Compound only**

Winter storage applications must be completed and posted through the Admin Office or mailed to the BYC Finance Director (Richard Spreckley) on or before Friday the 14<sup>th</sup> September 2018. Please **DO NOT make any payment at this time.**

Requests will be considered and allocated on the 15<sup>th</sup> September. Any boats not requiring storage for the winter period or declined storage for the winter period must be removed from the Compound one week prior to Crane out so the compound can be cleared and set for winter Storage.

NOTE: - **For Keelboats requiring a Crane Lift, The Signed Storage Waiver form and full payment for storage must be made before entering the compound**

Terms, conditions and Compound Rules: -

1. The Storage Waiver form and full payment must be made before any lifting
2. Lifting of the boat into the compound is down to the owner and is not a facility provided by the Brixham Yacht Club.
3. Cradles must be removed from the compound within 24 hours of Crane-In next season
4. All hoses are to be put away tidily after use and the yard around your boat to be kept tidy
5. Electricity can be sourced from sockets on the outside of the wooden shed, no power leads to be left out overnight. Electricity is ONLY available between 08:00 – 17:00 Daily
6. No De-Humidifiers
7. No Oil or Fuel to be left around the compound
8. Old Batteries can be left alongside the electric shed for disposal
9. No moving of any support props without help from an experienced person
10. Any boat that required moving mid storage season must have a full experienced yard crew
11. Any work undertaken by an outside company will incur a charge for Electric and Water of £10 per day or part thereof for Water and £10 per day or part thereof for electricity
12. ***No spraying of any material except water*** without the boat being fully encased in a protective tent to protect other boats in the area

AGREEMENT

Brixham Yacht Club (an Unincorporated Association) - "the Club"

1. This Agreement governs the terms upon which the Owner may store a boat or other marine vessel ("the vessel") in or on Club premises
2. The Owner has deposited or shall deposit with the Club a sum as specified in the Club notice of storage charges for the winter/summer period for the purpose of providing consideration for this Agreement and in anticipation of being permitted to store the vessel in or on Club premises
3. On completion of this Agreement, the following provisions shall have effect:
  - a) The Owner shall be permitted to store the vessel for the appropriate period referred to in the notice of storage charges subject to all conditions stated in that notice such storage to take place in the area of the Club determined by the Club
  - b) The Owner shall make his/her own arrangements for the ingress/egress/hoisting/lifting of the vessel in relation to the Club premises
  - c) If requiring support, the Owner shall ensure that at all times the vessel is adequately supported
  - d) The vessel shall be insured by the Owner against third party risks in the sum of at least £ 2 million.
  - e) The Club may at any time, at the Owner's risk, move the vessel, if it is capable of being carried or transported on a trolley or trailer, inside or outside the Club premises
  - f) The Owner agrees that if he/she requests any Club officer or member to assist in activity under sub clauses (b) and (e), that the officer or member will be acting as the personal agent of the Owner and that no liability in contract or tort shall fall upon the Club, nor its Officers nor members
  - g) The Owner agrees to indemnify the Club, its Officers and Members for all actions claims costs and demands arising in connection with the vessel and it storage
